Ofsted Inspection

Congratulations and well done All Saints! For any school that was judged as a 'good' school at their last inspection, Ofsted now conduct a one day 'short inspection'. As you know we had ours on January 23rd and you have had a copy of the report that now comes in the style of a letter. A copy of this is on the school website. We were thrilled with the inspector's views about our school and received the best possible outcome from this new style inspection.

*"The leadership team has maintained the good quality of education in the school since the last inspection. Based on the evidence gathered during this short inspection, I am of the opinion that the school has demonstrated strong practice in certain areas. **This may indicate that the school is improving towards being outstanding.** Therefore, I am recommending that the school's next inspection be a section 5 inspection."*

The inspector was particularly complimentary about the school's curriculum design, the relationships with you, our families, the quality of teaching and praised the effort staff go to in supporting our children. For example:

"Ensuring that pupils remain safe and thrive in a happy environment is a key priority for everyone who works at the school. Leaders are tenacious in following up safeguarding matters when other agencies are slow to respond. Staff go 'above and beyond' to support families, working closely with other agencies and organisations, to get them the help and support they need. You have developed a strong, trusting relationship between home and school which is beneficial to both the pupils' personal and academic outcomes."
