In School Transition

Children will have the opportunity to meet and work with new teachers and support staff during transition week which is week beginning 2nd July.

If your child is currently in Reception class, you will be notified by the EYFS team if they are in Class 1 or Class 2 when they move to year 1. The children have already been working in these groups for some time and preparing for their move to year 1 so are very familiar with it.
